Annetta J. Knull, 96, of Urbana, died at 8:40 P.M. Saturday, December 6, 2014 in her residence. She was born March 21, 1918 in Minier, IL, the daughter of Henry and Erma (Hoose) Gainer.

She was a 1936 graduate of Urbana High School and 1941 graduate of Bowling Green State University where she received a B.S. in Education. Annetta taught at Urbana City Schools and retired from Triad High School where she taught home economics.

She was a member of Urbana United Methodist Church where she was very active. Annetta was also a member of the Urbana-Champaign County Senior Citizens Center and she was named the Outstanding Senior Citizen of the Year. She was a member of the Champaign County Retired Teachers Association and Ohio Retired Teachers Association and was a volunteer tutor at The Caring Kitchen and volunteer for Meals on Wheels.
