David F. Inskeep, 45, of Urbana, died Friday, January 24, 2014 in Columbus, OH.

David, an All Ohio Football Player in 1985 and MVP for the Hillclimbers, graduated from Urbana High School in 1986, and attended the University of Dayton. He was the owner and instructor of the OTB Emergency Training, traveling throughout Ohio teaching.

David, a member of the Urbana Moose, was an avid Cincinnati Bengals fan, and loved fishing and dogs.
