Dennis E. Young, 63, of Urbana, died at his Urbana residence on Sunday, May 11, 2014.

He was born on June 13, 1950 in Urbana, OH, the son of James and Anna (Stapleton) Young. Dennis graduated from Urbana High School in 1968 and served in the United States Army during the Vietnam conflict. He worked at IH, beginning in January 1969.

Dennis loved the outdoors and enjoyed running, walking, biking, fishing, hunting, snow skiing and playing corn hole. He always supported American Red Cross blood drives, donating over 25 gallons of blood.

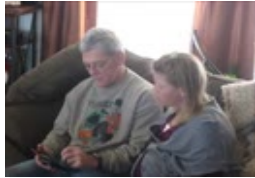
