Jennie L. Martin, 82, of Urbana, died at 9:40 a.m. on Tuesday, October 7, 2014 in her residence.

She was born on September 6, 1932 in Champaign County, OH, the daughter of William Henry and Beulah (Kemp) Smail. Jennie was a 1950 graduate of Urbana High School, a member of the Urbana United Methodist Church and a member of the Democratic Party. She, along with her husband Don, owned and operated Martin's Market in Kingscreek until closing in 1969. She then worked for the Madison-Champaign Educational Service Center (Mac-O-Chee), retiring with 30 years of service.

Jennie loved to attend all of the grandchildren's activities and also loved bicycle riding and to eat at restaurants with friends.
