



## Louise Antoinette Dwyer

March 7, 1930 - November 23, 2014

Louise Antoinette (Culley) Dwyer, 84, went to be with our Lord, surrounded by family, on Sunday, November 23, 2014 at Springfield Regional Medical Center, after a brief illness.
