May 16, 1925 - July 31, 2015

Mildred "Millie" L. (Plumly) Dallas, age 90, passed away peacefully at her home, on Friday, July 31, 2015. Millie was born to the late Mansel and Columbia Justina (Mason) Plumly on May 16, 1925 in Barnesville, Ohio. She graduated from Barnesville High School, and later married the love of her life, James C. Dallas.
