



Terrance "Terry" Harrigan

October 10, 1957 - July 26, 2014

Terrance L. "Terry" Harrigan, 56, of Brookville, died on Saturday, July 26, 2014 in the OSU Medical Center, Columbus.

He was born on October 10, 1957 in Urbana, OH, the son of James Paul and Patricia (Mutschler) Harrigan. Terry was a 1976 graduate of Urbana High School and attended the University of Dayton. He had worked as an electrician for MAHLE (formerly Behr) in Dayton and was a member of St. Mary Church.
