Walter J. Poe, Sr., 92, of Urbana, died at 5:32 p.m. on Monday, December 17, 2012 in Mercy Memorial Hospital, Urbana.

He was born on March 2, 1920 in Grafton, WV, the son of Stephen Lewis and Nevia Edna (Austin) Poe. Walter served in the United States Army during WWII and retired from Howard Paper Mill in 1984 after 44 years of service.
